This is home to half of Scotland's malt whiskey distilleries. They produce mellow, sweet, malty, and particularly fruity malt whiskeys.

Glenfiddich Special Reserve	\$9	Fresh pears, fruity, sweet + light
Glenlivet 12yr	\$10	Light, peachy + floral with soft vanilla
Glenlivet 15yr	\$12.00	Rich + flowery with a hint of orange
Glenlivet 18yr	\$14	Silky, spice + exotic fruitiness
Macallan 12yr	\$12	Hints of dried fruits, spice + chocolate orange
Macallan 18yr	\$27	Dried fruits + ginger, with a hint of vanilla
Macallan 25yr	\$50	Citrus, balanced with cinnamon, sherry + wood

HIGHLAND MALTS

These whiskeys will range from dry + heathery to sweet + fruity. Some even have a touch of smoke due to their proximity to the west coast.

The islands, in general produce some of the most robust whiskeys with coastal influences like salt tang and fresh sea air. However it more specifically Islay that produces the heavy, peaty, smoky tasting malts.
